



How to get your PADI certificate @ Lekker Gezellig Dive resort?

General overview

PADI diving courses at our resort include e-learning as well as practising and training your diving skills with our PADI certified dive instructor.

You can already start your study online and finish your PADI eLearning before you start your diving skills training at our resort. You can practice at our pool before starting your open water dives.

Note: You must be medically fit to dive and the required age for starting the Open Water course is 10 years or older.

Booking & payment

Contact us to book the course you want to follow (see section 'contact' on our webpage). You can then:

- Make a reservation for the course and our PADI instructor will contact you.
To make a reservation, a deposit of 25% is required.

You can pay in Euros, to NL91 ABNA 0422 2471 97, C. Lorangasal. Please mention your full name and the name of the PADI course.

- Our PADI instructor will contact you and can arrange everything, including your registration for the e-learning course. You will receive a link to the PADI website to start your e-learning course.

Please note:

- **Full payment must be made before arrival**
- **Cancellation** more than 30 days before arrival = full refund of deposit (minus the cost of the e-learning course if already booked; price varies per the course)

You can choose to directly order and pay the e-learning at the PADI website (at your local PADI dive center) and later follow the skills training and receive your registration at our resort. Because our PADI course prices include e-learning, we can then give you a discount.

Medical check(list)

Before starting your PADI course it is good to know if there are any medical conditions for which you may need to get a medical statement and approval from a physician:

This ensures that you're fit to dive and helps keep you safe underwater!

If there are no specific medical conditions to account for, you can fill in this form and other PADI forms later at our resort (Downloadable PADI Forms and Paperwork | PADI).

Step1: Registration for the course

For starting your e-learning at Lekker Gezellig resort, our PADI instructor will require:

- The name of the PADI course you want to follow
- Your full name (first name, last name)
- Your birth date
- Your e-mail address


Step2: PADI applications

1. Download PADI apps: Go to the Google Play store or Apple's App store: one with a white background (PADI account app), the other with a blue background (PADI e-learning app).




2. Create a PADI account - **If you already have an account: go directly to Step2!**


- Open the app with the white background to create a PADI account.
- Click on *Create an account*
- Click on *More* and then on *Account*



- Click on *Edit Account Details*: Enter your email address and choose a password.



- Click on *Profile*, then enter your full name, date of birth and upload a photo.



- Complete your account by adding the necessary details (follow instructions).

Step 3: E-learning

Once you are registered, you will have direct access to the theoretical part of the course.

In the e-learning app you find all your PADI Training materials (for downloading).

1. Open the e-learning app (blue background) and log in with the email address and password you also used for the PADI account app.
2. Choose the course you want to follow¹.
3. Learn and complete the theory at your own pace.

You will receive a certificate of completion for the e-learning portion of the PADI Open Water Diver course. This certificate can be printed or shown digitally.

Step 4: Skill practice

The skill practice will often start with a short review of the information learned during the e-learning to ensure understanding. After that, you will start learning and practicing your new diving skills by:

1. Confined Water Dives

You will first practice skills in our swimming pool or a confined water environment under the guidance of our instructor.

2. Open Water Dives

After completing the confined water dives, you make your open water dives. You will apply

your skills in a real diving environment.

Step 5: Certification

After successfully completing both theory and practice, the instructor confirms that the participant has met all requirements.

The instructor records course completion with PADI. You will then receive your PADI certificate. This is usually sent via email and can also be converted into a physical card.
